

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 25-26 ACADEMIC YEAR

SCHOOL OF SCIENCES

The following are the criteria for accreditation of the level of English to be met by those students who begin any of the bilingual programs offered by the Faculty in the 2025-2026 academic year.

- Degree in Environmental Sciences
- Degree in Environmental Sciences + International Science Program
- Double Degree in Biology + Environmental Sciences
- Double Degree in Biology + Environmental Sciences + International Science Program

If the required level is obtained in the admission test, it is not necessary to submit any additional documents.

If in the admission test they have not reached the required level, they must present before April 4, 2025 ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES:

- CAMBRIDGE EXAM: FIRST CERTIFICATE
- CAMBRIDGE EXAM: LINGUASKILL LEVEL B2 TOEFL 72 POINTS OR HIGHER.
- ESCUELA OFICIAL DE IDIOMAS: B2 LEVEL
- DUOLINGO ENGLISH TEST + 95 POINTS / B2 LEVEL

Important Note:

Students who are going to study: Degree in Environmental Sciences and Double Degree in Biology + Environmental Sciences and have not accredited the required level by the established date, must accredit it in the enrollment of the second year. In the case of not obtaining it, admission to the degree in Biology will be assessed.

Students who are going to take the Degree in Environmental Sciences + International Science Program and have not accredited their level of English by the established date will not be able to take the International Science Program, enrolling in Environmental Sciences, as long as there are places available, and must accredit their level of English at the time of formalizing their enrollment in the 2nd year.
