



ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 25- 26 ACADEMIC YEAR - SCHOOL OF LAW

The following are the criteria for accreditation of the level of English to be met by those students who will begin any of the following degrees offered by the School in the 2025-2026 academic year:

Degree in International Relations

Dual Degree in International Relations and Law Dual Degree in International Relations and History

The deadline for accreditation is April 4, 2025.

It will be sufficient to prove ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES to meet the requirement:

- FIRST CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH: score 170 points or higher
- CERTIFICATE IN ADVANCED ENGLISH
- CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY ENGLISH
- CAMBRIDGE LINGUASKILL TEST: 170 points or higher
- TOEFL, 77 points or higher
- LEVEL B2 OF THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE SCHOOL
- 5 IN IELTS
- BACCALAUREATE AT AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL
- STUDENTS WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION WAS ENGLISH
- INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE STUDENTS. LANGUAGE B

Bachelor's Degree in International Relations + Geopolitics & Diplomacy Bachelor's Degree in International Relations + Global Business & Economic Affairs

The deadline for accreditation is April 4, 2025.

It will be sufficient to prove ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES to meet the requirement:

- CERTIFICATE IN ADVANCED ENGLISH
- CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY ENGLISH
- CAMBRIDGE LINGUASKILL EXAM: level C1
- TOEFL, 95 points or higher
- LEVEL C1 OF THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE SCHOOL
- 6-7 IN IELTS
- BACCALAUREATE AT AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL
- STUDENTS WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION WAS ENGLISH
- INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE STUDENTS. LANGUAGE B

Important Note:

Those students who cannot prove their English level before April 4 can fill out a request through the myUNAV Portal in Help/Contact.

Those students whose education or mother tongue has not been Spanish, must accredit level B2 of DELE (Diplomas of Spanish as a Foreign Language) of the Cervantes Institute for Law degrees.
