

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 25-26 ACADEMIC YEAR

SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS

The following are the criteria for accreditation of the level of English to be met by those students who begin any of the bilingual programs offered by the Faculty in the 2025-2026 academic year:

The deadline for accreditation is April 4, 2025.

It will be sufficient to prove ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES to meet the requirement:

- CAMBRIDGE PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION (CAMBRIDGE ESOL EXAMS)

- CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED EXAMINATION (CAMBRIDGE ESOL EXAMS)

- CAMBRIDGE EXAM: 170 POINTS OR HIGHER

- TOEFL WITH THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: SCORE 80 POINTS OR HIGHER.

- STUDENTS WHO HAVE ATTENDED THE LAST TWO YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL IN AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION HAS BEEN ENGLISH.

- STUDENTS WHO HAVE FOLLOWED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE: LANGUAGE B, GRADE OF 5 OR HIGHER IN ENGLISH, STANDARD LEVEL.

The Faculty accepts online TOEFL tests (TOEFL IBT Special Home Edition) or Cambridge Linguaskill tests: https://www.cambridgeenglish.org/es/exams- andtests/linguaskilltest/

Important Note:

Those students who cannot accredit the required level of English before April 4 and who are interested in taking any of the bilingual programs in which they have been admitted, must enroll in the Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and Management + Business Management and Strategy or in Business Administration and Management + Law and may complete an application through the miUNAV portal to maintain their place in the bilingual degree.

If the level of English is not accredited, the student will not be able to take the bilingual option and will keep the option chosen in Spanish
