

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 25-26 ACADEMIC YEAR

SCHOOL OF NURSING

The following are the criteria for accreditation of the level of English to be met by those students who begin the Bachelor's **Degree in Nursing + International Nursing Program** in the 2025-2026 academic year:

To access this program it is necessary to have a grade point average of 7 out of 10 in the first year of high school or equivalent, in addition to proving the level of English before April 4, 2025 with ONE OF THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

- CAMBRIDGE FIRST OR HIGHER EXAM (CAMBRIDGE ESOL EXAMS)
- CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATION: LINGUASKILL LEVEL B2
- TOEFL WITH THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
- * IBT (INTERNET-BASED TOTAL): 72 POINTS OR HIGHER
- LEVEL B2 OF THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE SCHOOL
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE ATTENDED THE LAST TWO YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL IN AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION HAS BEEN ENGLISH.
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE FOLLOWED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE: LANGUAGE A2, GRADE OF 5 OR HIGHER IN ENGLISH, STANDARD LEVEL.

If the required level is obtained in the admission test, it is not necessary to submit any additional documents.

Important note:

Those students who cannot accredit the required level of English before April 4 must enroll in the Nursing degree in Spanish
