Accreditation for the Degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics (Bilingual) / Degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics – PPE

The criteria for accreditation of the level of English that must be met by those students who begin the Degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics (Bilingual) / Degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics – PPE, in the academic year 2024-2025:

The deadline for accreditation will be April 4, 2025.

It will be enough to prove ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TITLES to meet the requirement:

- FIST CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH (CAMBRIDGE ESOL EXAMS)
- CAMBRIDGE EXAM: LINGUASKILL LEVEL B2
- TOEFL WITH THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: IBT (INTERNET-BASED TOTAL): 72 POINTS OR HIGHER
- LEVEL B2 OF THE OFFICIAL SCHOOL OF LANGUAGES
- IELTS 5.0-5.5-6.0
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THE LAST TWO YEARS OF BACCALAUREATE IN A INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION HAS BEEN ENGLISH.
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE FOLLOWED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE: LANGUAGE A2, GRADE 5 OR MORE IN ENGLISH, STANDARD LEVEL

If the required level is obtained in the admission test, it is not necessary to present any additional documents.
