

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 25-26 ACADEMIC YEAR

DEGREE IN COMPUTER ENGINEERING AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

The following are the criteria for accreditation of the level of English to be met by those students who will start the Degree in Computer Engineering and Artificial Intelligence in the 2025-2026 academic year:

The deadline for accreditation is April 4, 2025.

It will be sufficient to prove ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES to meet the requirement:

- FIST CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH (CAMBRIDGE ESOL EXAMS) CERTIFICATE
- CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATION: LINGUASKILL LEVEL B2
- TOEFL WITH THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: IBT (INTERNET-BASED TOTAL): 72 POINTS OR HIGHER.
- LEVEL B2 OF THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE SCHOOL
- IELTS 5.0-5.5-6.0
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE ATTENDED THE LAST TWO YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL IN AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL WHOSE LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION HAS BEEN ENGLISH.
- STUDENTS WHO HAVE FOLLOWED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE: LANGUAGE A2, GRADE OF 5 OR HIGHER IN ENGLISH, STANDARD LEVEL.
